

Nationally accredited and locally recognized, our programs are unsurpassed. Our "Ready to Read" Early Literacy Program continues to grow and evolve with new partners and resources collaborating with us. An early math curriculum is integrated into the daily activities of children of all age groups. It is designed to introduce basic math concepts and prepare them to learn math once they enter school. These two programs help to ensure school readiness for our children.

But our programs are not all about academics – far from it. "Healthy Connections" recognizes the important role that good health habits, sound nutrition, physical fitness and early health screenings can play in a child's life. Ground-breaking programs like our Early Intervention Program continue to innovate and lead the industry. LBDN also recognizes the critical importance of social and emotional development, which is facilitated primarily through play, both structured and unstructured. As a result, you will always find children at play at both of our sites.

As a matter of fact, play is so important to optimal child development that it has been recognized by the United Nations High Commission for Human Rights as a fundamental right of every child. For a complete description of our current programs, please see page 4.

Sunshine Day Encourages Parent Involvement

unshine Day open houses have been a staple at Long Beach Day Nursery for more than 19 years. Designed to be interactive between the children and guests, and to illustrate the LBDN curriculum, a cooking activity, for example, helps the children learn how to measure, and provides sensory stimulation and motor skill development through stirring and shaking ingredients.

Sunshine Day is traditionally scheduled in the fall. At the West Branch this year, some of the activities offered included making sun visors that encourage creative expression, planting flowers to emphasize science and discovery activities, participation in an obstacle course to utilize large muscles, balance and coordination, and face painting for language and dramatic play.

"The parents enjoy the opportunity to spend time with their children and to get to know more about LBDN," said West Branch Center Director Linda Blackshire. "We have activities going on in

all of the classrooms and outside. The children really enjoy this event and the parents get to see firsthand the skills that their children are learning, as well as the playtime activities."

Similar activities are scheduled at the East Branch. "It is wonderful to see the families engaging in the activities that their children typically participate in while at Long Beach Day Nursery," said Amy Bigelow, program director. "I believe through their participation, the families are better able to understand how their children are learning while they are interacting with their peers, teachers and the learning environment."

Sunshine Day encourages all guests to participate in all of the activities, not just those in their children's classroom. And, they are given the opportunity to tour the entire facility and to meet the teachers.



"Parent participation is a critical part of our programs and therefore we offer many ways for parents to be involved," said Amy Bigelow, program director. "Some parents participate by attending our Parent Advisory Committee

meetings, parent education meetings or one of

several special events during the year."

LBDN Programs Encourage Personal Development and Growth

ong Beach Day Nursery is dedicated to being a partner with working parents to encourage, foster and promote the personal development and growth of each child. Our programs provide a balance of physical nurturing and exercise, emotional support and encouragement, and intellectual stimulation and growth. "Every time I visit one of the branches for an event like Sunshine Days, Picture Days or Fall Feasts, I am impressed again by the warmth and attention shown to each child by our wonderful staff and their commitment to providing a program of the highest quality," said Melanie Werts, program committee chair. "I am very proud to be a member of the board of directors and a part of the LBDN team."

Our experienced, professional staff provides individualized programs that nurture the whole child and is a testament to our dedication to the belief that a good start in the formative years of childhood provides children with a lasting foundation for success throughout their lives. LBDN currently offers many value-added programs for families that serve to ensure a solid foundation of quality care and early education for their children.

"Ready to Read" Early Literacy Program

This program focuses on classroom literacy and language development activities including at least two hours of these activities each day in each classroom. Libraries are also available at each site that include not only books, but CDs, cassette tapes, games and other activities that parents may check out to support and encourage intergenerational reading activities at home. The 'Ready to Read' program is also enhanced with the following programs:

- Raising a Reader: In partnership with the Long Beach Public Library, our 'Raising a Reader' program is a well-regarded, national literacy program that features a 12-week rotation of take-home award-winning children's books along with library visits. The program also aims to build relationships between the public library and families of young children. Each year, we introduce at least 100 families to the library. More than three-fourths of these families obtain preschool library cards for their children.
- **ABC Me Sign:** This program teaches pre-verbal children to use American Sign Language for communicating with their parents and caregivers. Using signs gives these children a way to "talk" with their parents, before they can talk.

Early Intervention Program

LBDN's groundbreaking Early Intervention program facilitates communication between our teachers and our staff child psychologist, Dr. Jana Martin, who in turn consults with the affected family and develops appropriate intervention strategies for use by teachers and parents. Parents are also referred to other community resources if the need is warranted. Each year, between 50 and 70 children are assessed for early intervention services.

"Parents as Partners"

This parent education program is designed to teach parents about child development, provide them with appropriate parenting techniques, educate them about the importance of their involvement with their children's education and to provide them with opportunities to give input to the center directors. A minimum of three to four workshops a year per site are made available to parents and are led by early childhood experts from throughout the community, as well as LBDN staff. Other events throughout the year that include the parents in their children's daily curriculum include Sunshine Days, Fall Feasts and Picture Days, to name a few. (cont. on pg. 5)

Universal Preschool

Universal Preschool began at the East Branch in June 2005 with 16 pre-kindergarten children and continues today with 20 children. The West Branch was awarded a provisional contract in April to implement Universal Preschool, and began with 15 children in July. The West Branch program now has 20 children enrolled.

While the curriculum LBDN uses with its Universal Preschool classrooms is no different from our nationally accredited preschool curriculum, the opportunity to spend focused time with children their same age allows these four-year-olds a chance to enhance their skills and development necessary for kindergarten readiness.

"Healthy Connections"

Recognizing the important role that good health habits, sound nutrition, and early health screenings can play in a child's life, LBDN offers a range of health services and education. The cornerstone of good health is good nutrition, and every child is provided two meals and at least one snack every day, prepared on-site according to USDA guidelines. Rice cereal and formula are available for our very youngest children, too. In addition to our food program, LBDN provides dental screenings each year to every child, as well as a parent workshop on pediatric dental health, and classroom instruction for preschoolers on proper dental habits. Staff in-service training and parent workshops on a variety of health topics are provided throughout the year. Finally, we strongly believe in physical exercise. Our playgrounds are designed to not only meet current health and safety guidelines, but are also inviting, attractive, and encourage a balance of active learning activities, opportunities for rest and reflection, and play with peers. Each day, children play, socialize and develop both large and small motor skills while exploring our playgrounds and gardens.

Math

Math is integrated throughout the day as children are doing activities, such as cooking and sand and water play, as well as during more routine times such as lining up to go outside or serving themselves lunch. Teachers create opportunities to use math concepts such as measurement and quantity, before and after, bigger and smaller to convey these concepts to children. In the new fiscal year, we will be completing a preschool mathematics teacher training program to introduce teachers to the five standards of early mathematics and how to include these standards in a manner that is developmentally appropriate at the preschool level.

"Each of our program components is developmentally appropriate, and all are designed with a balance of activities that facilitate social, emotional, physical and creative development as well as academic readiness. We nurture the whole child."

"Liam first began using sign language in his Infant 2 classroom," said Dr. Christie Bixby, Liam's mom. "This program really made a big difference for all of us. We were better able to communicate with him at home, he was able to express his own desires and we were able to understand what he was trying to communicate. Now at age two-and-a-half, Liam is transitioning from non-verbal to verbal communications and continues to use some of the signs he has learned."


ollye and Rebecca Gotz, daughters of new board member Jon Gotz, attended the Long Beach Day Nursery in the late 1980s and early 1990s.
